Weekends 11am to 4.30pm.



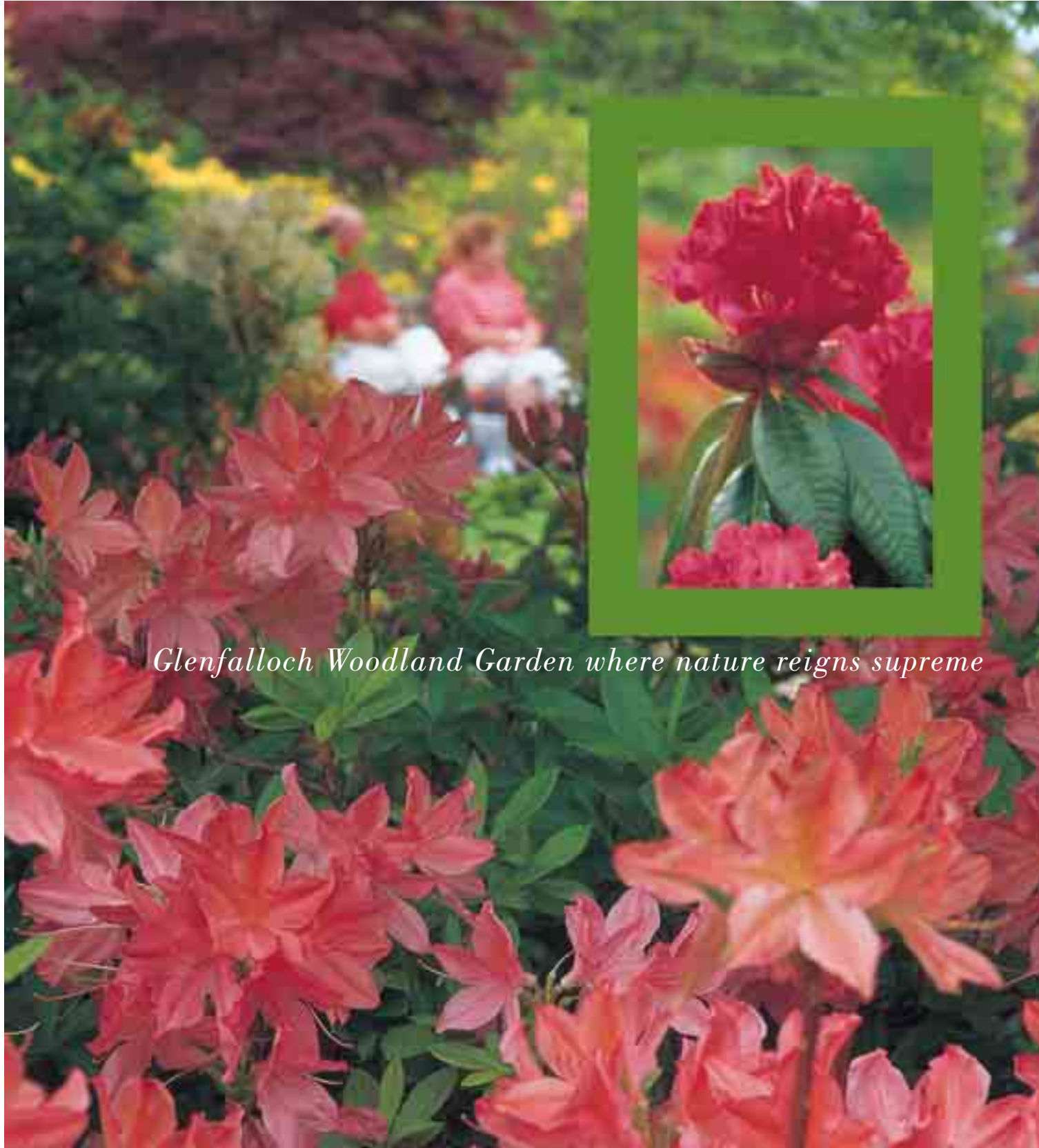

Welcome to Glenfalloch Woodland Garden. Enjoy the peace and tranquillity and the panoramic harbour views; listen to the gentle ripple of Russell Creek and the harmony of a native birdlife symphony. Walk among the rhododendrons, azaleas, magnolias, fuchsias and a profusion of other flower species which integrate with native ferns, exotic imports and indigenous New Zealand trees to showcase 120 years of conservation and expansion of our botanical heritage. Glenfalloch is located on the Otago Peninsula, 15 minutes from the City Centre.

Glenfalloch, gaelic for 'hidden valley' enjoys a micro-climate that extends the seasons and nurtures growth. Mature oak, walnut, elm, horse chestnut, birch, English beech and other imported and native trees pay homage to a 1000-year-old matai which has pride of place.

Visit the Potter's Cottage. Refreshments at the Cafe/ Wine Bar extend to a light snack and sweet treat complemented by an extensive range of imported and New Zealand wines and ales. Sunday lunch at the Chalet is also a rewarding culinary experience. Bon appetit!
